Meeting was called to order at 12:10 pm

Agenda

Guest Brett Miller from Royal Engineered Composites gave a presentation about what they do at Royal that sets them apart from other companies in their industry. They also gave a tour of the facility after the business meeting.

Approval of Secretary's Report – because a quorum was not present, Amy Fuqua was called and on speaker phone for the vote to approve the Secretary's and Treasurer's reports. Nickola moved to approve the Secretary's report, Dawn seconded. All voted in favor to approve minutes as presented.

Approval of Financial Report – Nickola moved to approve the Treasurer's report. Angie seconded. All voted in favor.

Event Updates -

- **Christmas Traditions updates** Sub committee chairs meet Oct. 14. Planning is in progress. Homes are being recruited for the Tour of Homes.
- **Bandfest Oct. 19** 31 bands are registered, which is about the number we usually have. Michelle Edgecombe is in need of volunteers to help and to provide cut, individually wrapped bars to sell.
- Halloween Parade Oct 31 Jasmine will lead the parade.
- **Harvest Lunch at CPI Date TBD –** Kathi thought that this would be a good way to use up the rest of the Ag BBQ leftovers. We will need to assemble the lunches. Additional items needed will be buns, bottled water and maybe a dessert item.

Other Agenda Items

- **Community Visits** Kathi has visited SGS Innovations, Buffy Kamery Mary Kay and Hangries. At this time we still have 25 non-renewing members on the list. She is working on reaching out to them.
- **Finance Committee update** No meeting yet. Amy expressed that she would like someone else to chair the committee, as she is the Treasurer. Chair will be Becca. Committee will also include Nickola and Amy. They will try to get together before the next meeting.
- **Nominations Committee** The outgoing board members will be in charge of recruiting people to place on the ballot (Simon, Kim, Connor, Kirk and Dawn are all outgoing, unless they choose to renew for another term.) Also needed are candidates willing to serve as President next year, since Kirk will no longer be on the board.
- **Tour de Nebraska** After receiving their official materials and proposal, it was decided that we just don't have the volunteers and resources to tackle 500+ riders during Dawg Days weekend. Dawn moved that we decline to host them. Amy seconded. All voted in favor.
- VP Resignation Discussion took place about the process of Kirk stepping down as Vice President. It was decided that he would need to submit a letter of resignation but seeing how close it is to the election of new officers, no new candidate would be appointed. We will keep that position open until then.
- **Annual Chamber Conference** Kathi attended the conference and will be sharing her notes in the future. Primarily she came back with insights into new tools and tips for social media and the management of membership information.
- **Holiday ornament for sale** Angie Horine talked to the middle school art teacher about possibly having the kids design a collectible ornament. They are definitely excited about the possibility. The school also has an app called Artsonia that can be used for voting and even for creating the artwork. She will continue to work with her to get more information. It was decided to award the winner \$50 in Chamber Bucks.

Dawn moved to adjourn at 1:10 pm. Nickola seconded. All voted in favor.
