Two Days of "Damp" FUN!

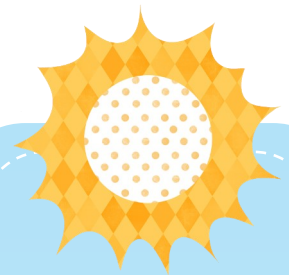

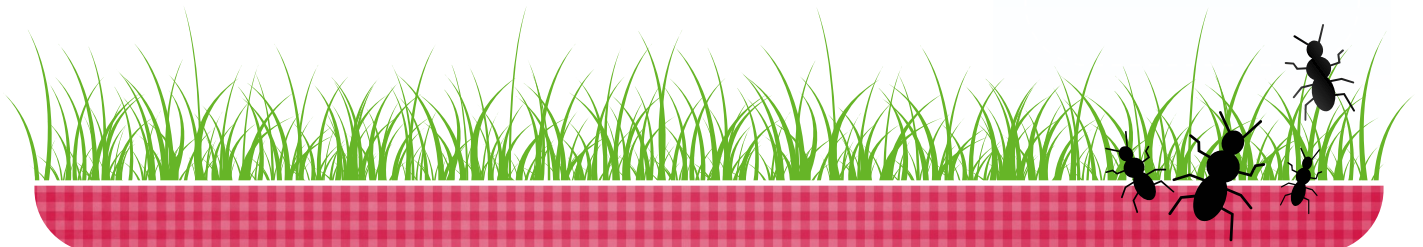
Car Show Cause!

June Chamber Minutes

Roll Call: Conner Peterson, Kim Snavelly, Dawn Thompson, Amy Fuqua, Kirk Peterson, Marcy Brandt, Angie Horine, Kevin Davis, Nickola VanHorn

Absent: Kendra Brown, Simon McKenzie, Becca Thornburg

Ex Officios: Not present

Meeting was called to order at 12:10 pm

Nickola moved to approve the Secretary's report. Kirk seconded. All voted in favor.

Amy presented the Treasurer's report. She is still working on cleaning up and reorganizing the Quickbooks so that everything will show the way that it should in future reports. She strongly recommends having a Finance Committee to meet and discuss how best to restructure things, rather than just making executive decisions. Committee members will be Connor, Nickola, and Rebecca. Dawn moved to approve the report. Angie seconded. All voted in favor.

Old Business

Dawg Days Updates – Sally Jurgensmier created some signs that need to be put up. Kathi is working on scheduling media interviews. Final committee meeting is Monday, June 10 at Cozy Corner at 8 am. There will be several food options available for both days and vendors are continuing to sign up for the craft show. Volunteers are needed for the gates, but the bar should be covered. The courthouse is not allowing us to use the restrooms in the building, so Kathi will arrange for more porta poties.

Community Visits-schedule to review – Kathi has a draft of a calendar for June. Each board member will sign up for a time spot to visit a business with her. There will be 12 visits this month.

New Business Recruitment – Kathi is hoping to gain 20 new members this year. The question was raised in how to handle non-profits.

Giving Day – Marcy and Dawn met with the Kearney County Community Foundation and felt that the feedback was extremely positive. No official decision has been passed down, but Marcy and Dawn will keep gathering information and will try to get a solid decision at their next meeting in August.

Flood Relief-update from Gibbon – Right now they don't need help, so we will drop it for now.

By-Law votes-final – The corrections have been approved. Amy is officially the Treasurer, and Connor has all of the signature cards updated with the current President, Vice President, Secretary, and Administrator all able to sign. The Treasurer is able to access the accounts but cannot sign.

New Business

Christmas Committee-July meeting start – Kathi will establish sub committees to handle the various moving parts. Lynette will Chair the Tour of Homes. Dawn will Chair Miss Christmas City. Carolyn Bunger will Chair the Kids' Carnival. A parade Chair will need to be found. Ladies' Night Out will be included. Date is set for Friday, Nov. 22.

July 4-firework updates – Kathi has met with the City and has all of the permissions and details in process. The City requested that the Chamber have money-takers there earlier and in a different location. Cozy will have their treat truck parked out and said that we could have a donation jar set up by the truck. Kathi suggested that we set up a Go Fund Me page two weeks prior to the event. We typically receive approximately \$1000 in donations at the gate. With the Go Fund Me, maybe we can bring in more funds.

Future Ribbon Cutting – Pony Express is still deciding on a date for their ribbon cutting. It sparked a discussion about how to best utilize and continue to keep the Ambassadors engaged.

Tour De Nebraska Bike Tour 2020 – They contacted the Chamber office to ask about being a host site. She talked to Mr. Widdifield at the school to ask about coordinating if we are chosen and/or are interested. It would theoretically fall during Dawg Days. It would be approximately 500 bikers. Kathi will request that Kathi's contact will come to the next meeting to give more details.

Meeting was adjourned at 1:15 pm
